

CHILDRENS PETTION TO THE PRESTDENT asking him to free all the little slave children in this country.


Petition of the Children of the United (underedges) States; that the President will free all slave children.

Mrs. Horace Mann Madame

The petition of persons under eighteen, praying that I would free all slave children, and tho heading of which petition, it appears you wrote, was handed me a few days since by Senator Sumner. Please tell these little people I am very glad their young hearts are so full of just and generous sympathy, and that, while I have not the power to grant all they ask, I trust they will remember that God has, and that, as it seems, He wills to do it.
